The NYC Solar Schools Education Program is hosted by the DOE Office of Sustainability and is delivered in partnership with Solar One.

This Program is <u>FREE</u> for grades 3-12 DOE teachers, offers CTLE credits, materials, and is delivered virtually.

A solar installation at your school is **NOT** required in order to participate in this Program.

Program participants must attend:

10 hours of virtual Professional Learning Workshops

Workshops are delivered in multiple shorter sessions and are offered during the school day, afterschool, or on weekends to accommodate a variety of schedules.

Program Benefits:

- Interactive activities and virtual lesson plans that align with the new Science Scope & Sequence, Regents exams, and Amplify curriculum.
- Strategies for incorporating climate change and renewable energy content into curriculum.
- **Free classroom materials** including multimeters, mini solar panels, and circuit supplies <u>after completing all 10 program hours</u>.
- An opportunity to apply for virtual 1-on-1 lesson planning and co-teaching with a Solar One Educator (limited availability).
